Collecting your children from BASH

Children must be picked up no later than 5.45 pm. Parents/carers **MUST** tell a member of staff that they are taking their children and sign them out.

If your child is being picked up by someone else, you **MUST** call or text to let a member of staff know the name of the person.

If a child(ren) are not collected after this time a late fee will be charged, £1 for every minute until 6 pm, then £5 every five minutes thereafter.

If a child(ren) are not picked up after every effort to contact a parent with the numbers provided, as a last resort social services will be called.
