## **WHAT HAPPENS IN YEAR 2**

#### Start and end of the Day:

All children can enter the school gate/building from **08:30** onwards as part of our staggered start to the day. All children must be in school by **08:40** and collected promptly at **15:10**. Children will be brought to the playground and parents will then be permitted to enter the playgrounds following the one way system in place. Children will be dismissed once parents have entered the playground and encouraged to keep moving to prevent any congestion. Parents and children must then vacate the playground immediately following the one way system.

If you would like to speak to your child's class teacher, please book an appointment via email as pupils safety at the beginning and end of the day is the priority.

#### P.E:

All children will participate in P.E. lessons on **Monday and Friday** afternoons starting Monday 13th September. Each child needs to arrive at school wearing a full school P.E. kit. Comprising a school logo T-shirt, black shorts/black tracksuit bottoms and black plimsolls.

#### **Reading books:**

P.A.C.T folders and books must be returned to school every **Friday.** This is so that reading books can be quarantined, then changed and sent home on a **Monday**. Please complete your child's Reading Record when you read with them at home. Regular reading to an adult or older brother/sister plays an important role in building your child's confidence in reading; it also helps them to access the school's curriculum more easily. If it is misplaced, you will need to replace it at a cost of £1.

#### **HOMEWORK/Spellings & Times tables:**

As a school, the expectations for homework are as follows:

- Daily reading
- Phonics and spelling rules/patterns posted weekly on Google Classrooms.
- Number and times table practise (2', 5's and 10's) using the computer programme NumBots. https://play.numbots.com/#/account/school-login/6660

Your child will be given a login and password so they can practise their maths skills and their teacher will monitor their progress each week.

#### **Uniform:**

Please ensure your child has a full school uniform and black shoes/trainers which are completely black. Children will also need a full PE kit and will be required to wear this on their PE days. These will be confirmed once the children return. We are planning to use our wonderful outdoor facilities more for playtimes and lunchtimes, including in wet weather. Please ensure your child has waterproof shoes/wellingtons and waterproof trousers for this. Please ensure all items of clothing/footwear are clearly named.

Please make sure these have your child's name clearly marked on all items of clothing.

#### Trips:

If any trips or workshops occur this year, you will receive information about them in good time.

#### Parent/Carer Helpers:

At present, we request that no parents/carers enter the school premises unless this has been pre-arranged. This will help everybody feel and stay much safer. Thank you to those of you who have helped previously.

#### **Snack and Milk:**

Fruit is provided and milk can be ordered if required.
