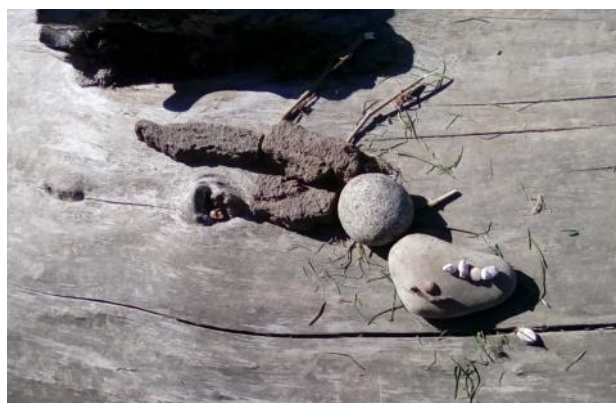

Look to the future and recapping on key techniques.

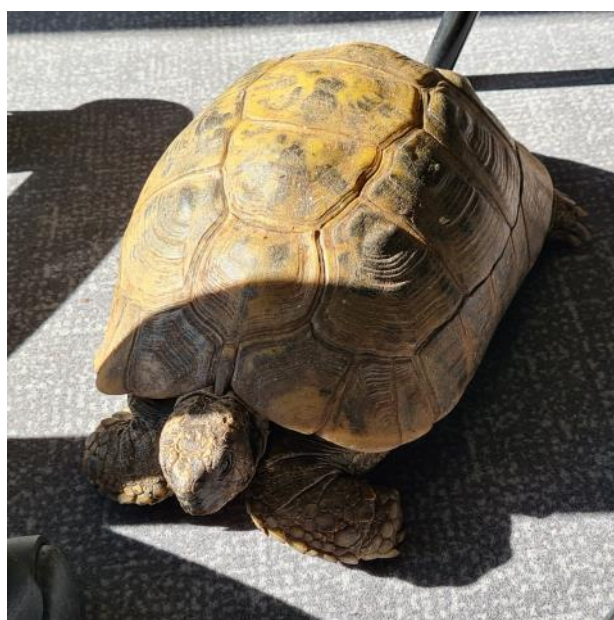
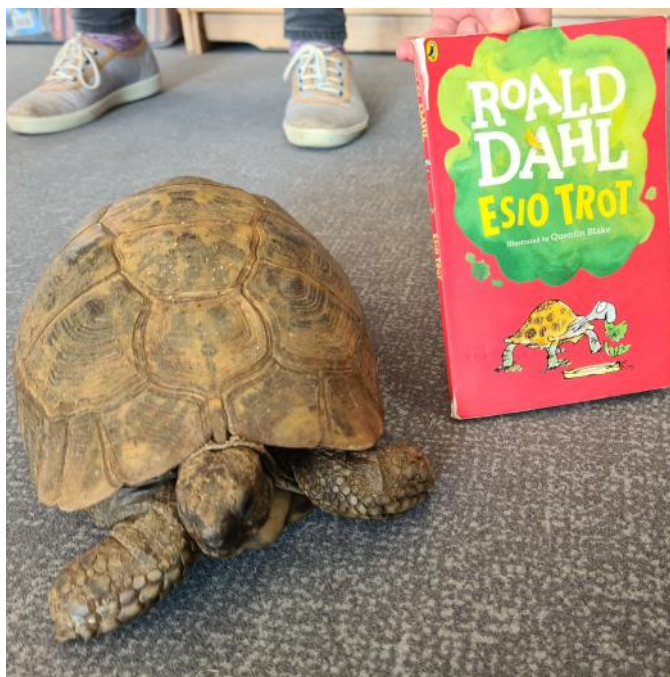
