

Where possible please walk, cycle or scoot to school, if you have to drive, park legally; do not park across the school gates or on corners. Thoughtless parking causes congestion and could put children's lives at risk.



A reminder; the children must be on either packed lunch or school meals, we need 2 weeks notice if you wish to change, it makes it very difficult for us to administer any changes and chef orders food on a two week cycle. You may get charged for a meal your child has not eaten and we are no longer able to make changes to ParentPay.



Free School Meals

Your child might be entitled to free school meals if you are receiving:

- 28 day Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit
- Child tax credit (not working tax credit) and annual income not in excess of £16,190
- Employment & Support Allowance (Income related)
- Income Support
- Jobseeker's allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999

- ◆ No chicken on the bone
- ◆ No yoghurts—we have no way to keep them cold
