**Tuesday, 25th January 10.15am to 11am**

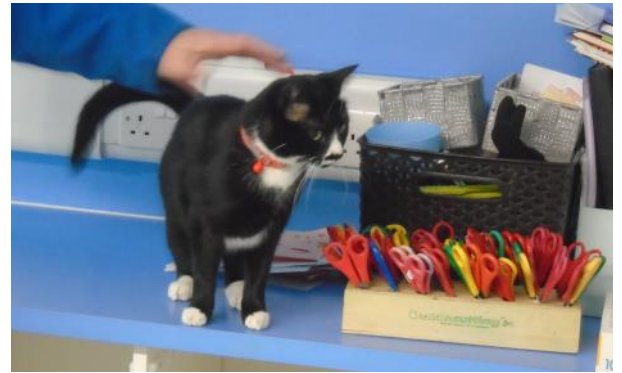
