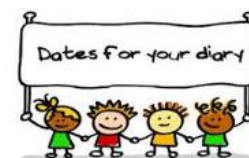

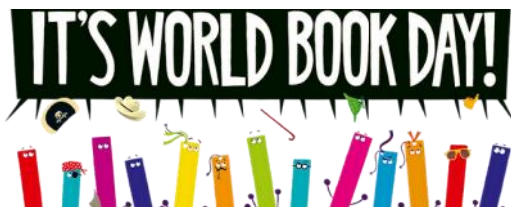

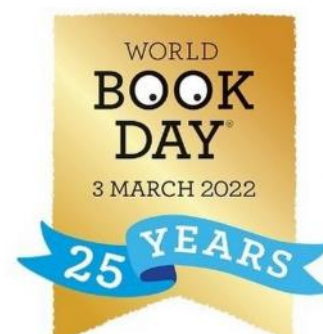

Cruella De Vil's, one even had her own dog!, and a Hungry Caterpillar to name a few!



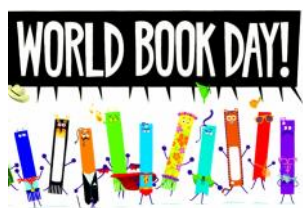
