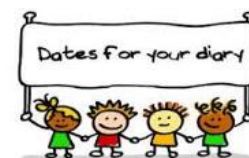
Next week looks to be an exciting one as we celebrate STEM week. I look forward to updating you with all the wonderful things that take place.

• Herbs & spices of your choice - e.g. paprika, chilli, garlic granules...	• Lightly brush or spray with oil
	• Sprinkle with chosen herbs or spices or a little salt
	• Bake in the oven for about 8 minutes
