After two years of upset caused by the pandemic, statutory testing for children has resumed this year and many year groups will be taking tests and assessments in the coming weeks:

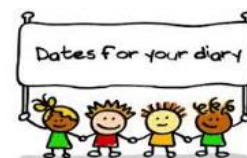
