





How will it work?

- Arundel Road (as marked below) will be a pedestrian and cycle only zone from 8:15 - 9:15am and 2:45 - 3:45pm on school days.
- Access is permitted for local residents and school staff subject to vehicle registration.
- Vehicles driven by parents/guardians are not permitted to enter the zone during the timed closure.
- > The School Street would be enforced by camera which means unauthorised vehicles entering the zone will be issued a penalty charge notice.



Blue badge holders are entitled to an exemption and can register their vehicle to gain access.




