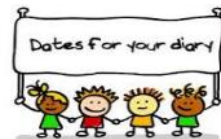

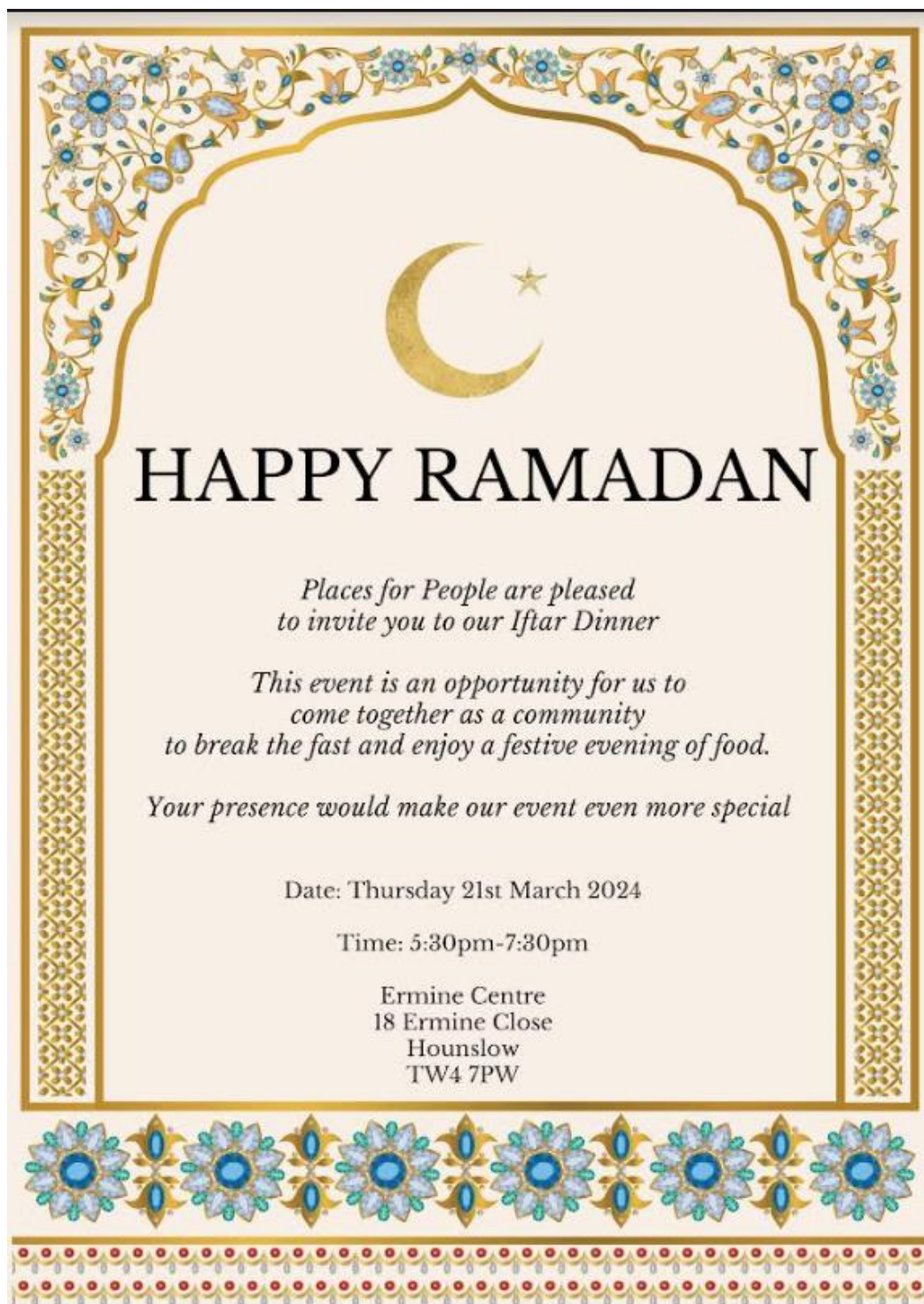
MAYOR ASKS TfL TO TRIAL **OFF PEAK FRIDAY TRAVEL**

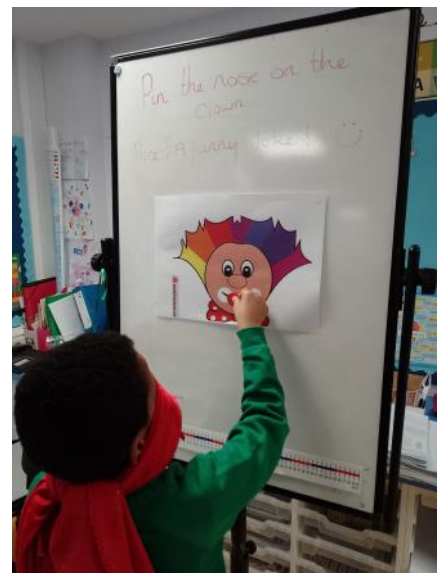
