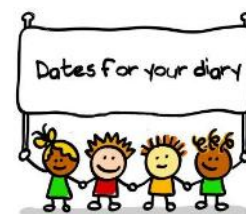




NEWSLETTER

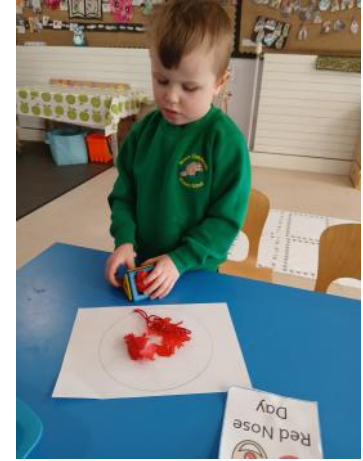
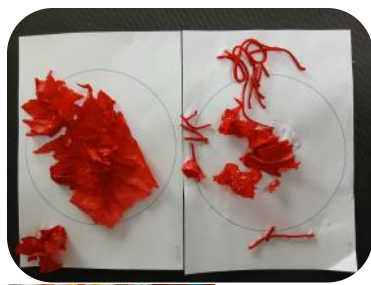
