Reception 2017

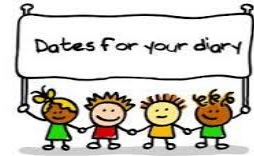
The offers have now been made for Reception 2017, we hope you got your first choice of school. Don't forget to accept the place online by Tuesday 2nd May.

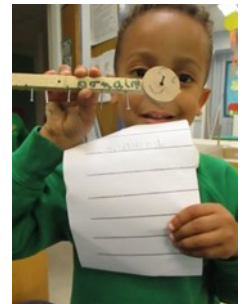
